Getting to Know Yourself

- The first step of the career exploration process is getting to know yourself. Take time to learn about your interests, strengths, personality and values.
 - Focus: This self-paced and holistic career planning tool includes 5 self-assessments and career exploration tools.
 - Strong Interest Inventory: Provides insight into connections between interests and potential careers.
 - Meet with an advisor in the Creighton Career Center to talk about your personality and goals and how they align with various careers.

- Why network?
 - Meet new and interesting people (mentors?)
 - Learn about the field, organization, industry, etc.
 - Find out about opportunities
 - To get a job! Hidden Job Market vs. Open Job Market
- Ways to network
 - At events, programs, conferences, etc.
 - Do an informational interview



Networking – Info Interviewing

- Where to find people:

- Your own network
- LinkedIn
- Clubs/organizations

Four step process:

1. Develop questions
2. Request the informational interview
3. Do the informational interview
4. Send a thank you/follow-up



Informational Interviews

- Email, phone, or in person: Who you are, how you found them, what you want

- Run internal Cost of Goods Sold reports using SAP software for the Finance department and Commercial Foods section budget

- Manage the monthly close process in which summary reports are produced for Finance department management
- Research cause when the close report does not reconcile (up to \$300 million)
- Write rules using SAP software to resolve the account while highlighting the accounts causing the errors and providing documentation for the steps used to zero the accounts
- Create SAP reports that found a total of \$25 billion in discrepancies, researched the cause, and determined the reports had been mapped to the wrong data source; once corrected all 11 WEBI reports zeroed
